	1	1 Corinthians 1:1	Paul, called <i>to be</i> an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes <i>our</i> brother,
	2	1 Corinthians 1:3	Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
	3	1 Corinthians 1:4	I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus
	4	1 Corinthians 1:9	God <i>is</i> faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
	5	1 Corinthians 1:10	Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and <i>that</i> there be no divisions among you, but <i>that</i> you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
	6	1 Corinthians 1:13	Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
	7	1 Corinthians 1:18	For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
	8	1 Corinthians 1:23	but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,
	9	1 Corinthians 1:31	that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the Lord."
	10	1 Corinthians 2:2	For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

11	1 Corinthians 2:9	But as it is written:“Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.”
12	1 Corinthians 2:13	These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
13	1 Corinthians 3:6	I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.
14	1 Corinthians 3:9	For we are God’s fellow workers; you are God’s field, you are God’s building.
15	1 Corinthians 3:11	For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
16	1 Corinthians 3:23	And you <i>are</i> Christ’s, and Christ <i>is</i> God’s.
17	1 Corinthians 4:2	Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.
18	1 Corinthians 4:10	We <i>are</i> fools for Christ’s sake, but you <i>are</i> wise in Christ! We <i>are</i> weak, but you <i>are</i> strong! You <i>are</i> distinguished, but we <i>are</i> dishonored!
19	1 Corinthians 5:13	But those who are outside God judges. Therefore “put away from yourselves the evil person.”
20	1 Corinthians 6:11	And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.
21	1 Corinthians 6:14	And God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power.
22	1 Corinthians 6:20	For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God’s.
23	1 Corinthians 7:23	You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of men.
24	1 Corinthians 7:39	A wife is bound by law as long as her husband lives; but if her husband dies, she is at liberty to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord.

- 25 1 Corinthians 8:13 Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never again eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.
- 26 1 Corinthians 9:9 For it is written in the law of Moses, "You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain." Is it oxen God is concerned about?
- 27 1 Corinthians 9:16 For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel!
- 28 1 Corinthians 9:19 For though I am free from all *men*, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more
- 29 1 Corinthians 9:24 Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it.
- 30 1 Corinthians 10:11 Now all these things happened to them as examples, and they were written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.
- 31 1 Corinthians 10:12 Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.
- 32 1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.
- 33 1 Corinthians 10:31 Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
- 34 1 Corinthians 11:1 Imitate me, just as I also *imitate* Christ.
- 35 1 Corinthians 11:23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread;
- 36 1 Corinthians 11:24 and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

- 37 1 Corinthians 11:25 In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me.”
- 38 1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death till He comes.
- 39 1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also *is* Christ.
- 40 1 Corinthians 12:27 Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.
- 41-44 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Love suffers long *and* is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; **5** does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; **6** does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; **7** bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
- 45 1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these *is* love.
- 46 1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- 47-48 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, **4** and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
- 49 1 Corinthians 15:20 But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.
- 50 1 Corinthians 15:26 The last enemy *that* will be destroyed *is* death.
- 51 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: “Evil company corrupts good habits.”
- 52 1 Corinthians 15:55 “O Death, where *is* your sting?
O Hades, where *is* your victory?”

- 53 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.
- 54 1 Corinthians 16:2 On the first *day* of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.
- 55 1 Corinthians 16:13 Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong.
- 56 1 Corinthians 16:14 Let all *that* you *do* be done with love.
- 57 1 Corinthians 16:23 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you.
- 58 1 Corinthians 16:24 My love *be* with you all in Christ Jesus. Amen.
- 59 2 Corinthians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 60 2 Corinthians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort
- 61 2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.
- 62 2 Corinthians 2:4 For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote to you, with many tears, not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the love which I have so abundantly for you.
- 63 2 Corinthians 2:11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

64	2 Corinthians 2:15	For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.
65	2 Corinthians 3:2	You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men;
66	2 Corinthians 3:18	But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.
67	2 Corinthians 4:3	But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing
68	2 Corinthians 4:4	whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
69	2 Corinthians 4:7	But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.
70	2 Corinthians 4:16	Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward <i>man</i> is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.
71	2 Corinthians 5:1	For we know that if our earthly house, <i>this</i> tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
72-73	2 Corinthians 5:6-7	So <i>we are</i> always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. 7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

- 74 2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
- 75 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died
- 76 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
- 77 2 Corinthians 5:20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.
- 78 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
- 79 2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."
- 80 2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 81 2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow produces repentance *leading* to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
- 82 2 Corinthians 8:7 But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us— *see* that you abound in this grace also.

- 83 2 Corinthians 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.
- 84-85 2 Corinthians 9:6-7 But this *I say*: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. **7** *So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.*
- 86 2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks *be* to God for His indescribable gift!
- 87 2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.
- 88 2 Corinthians 10:17 But “he who glories, let him glory in the Lord.”
- 89 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.
- 90-93 2 Corinthians 11:25-28 Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep; **26** *in* journeys often, *in* perils of waters, *in* perils of robbers, *in* perils of *my own* countrymen, *in* perils of the Gentiles, *in* perils in the city, *in* perils in the wilderness, *in* perils in the sea, *in* perils among false brethren; **27** *in* weariness and toil, *in* sleeplessness often, *in* hunger and thirst, *in* fastings often, *in* cold and nakedness— **28** besides the other things, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches.

- 94-97 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. **8** Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. **9** And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **10** Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
- 98 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves *as to* whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.
- 99 2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
- 100 2 Corinthians 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit *be* with you all. Amen.
